



## This mansion is being auctioned ... online!

This is what the housing market has come to. A British dot.com entrepreneur has had no luck selling his house, so he's inviting the world

to watch him auction it today at 1 p.m. According to Continental Realty Auctions and Illustrated Properties, Stuart Lawley, forced to sell because of a divorce, is holding an auction of his 5-bedroom, 8.5-bath, 13,000-square-foot home on the Loxahatchee River on the Internet. Web surfers from around the world can watch the action and even bid, as long as they can

afford the minimum price of \$4.5 million. The Mediterranean-style house with 160 feet for Malcolm Healey, a British kitchen cabinet maker who founded the Mills Pride cabinet company. Lawley bought the house in 2001 for \$5.9 million. Two years ago, the Palm Beach County property appraiser valued it at slightly more than \$6 million. The property includes a 1,200-square-foot guesthouse with 2 bedrooms and 2 baths.
